All may make the sign of the cross, the sign that is marked at baptism, as the presiding minister begins.

Pastor: Blessed be the holy Trinity,

one God, our maker, our helper, and our keeper.

All: Amen.

Pastor: Trusting in God's mercy, let us confess our sin in the presence of God and of one another.

Silence is kept for reflection.

Pastor: Merciful and loving God,

All: we are your stiff-necked people.

We trample on the needy.

We grumble about your grace to others.

We turn away from the poor.

Have mercy on us and forgive our sins.

Rejoice over us as ones who were lost and have been found.

Amen.

Pastor: Even when we are faithless, God remains faithful.

Jesus Christ came into the world to save sinners.

You who were lost have been found.

In the name of + Jesus, your sins are forgiven!

All: Amen.

PRAYER OF THE DAY

All: Almighty and most merciful God, your bountiful goodness fills all creation. Keep us safe from all that may hurt us, that, whole and well in

body and spirit, we may with grateful hearts accomplish all that you would have us do, through Jesus Christ, our Savior and Lord. Amen.

(Confirmands come forward.)

AFFIRMATION OF BAPTISM

Pastor: Let us pray. Merciful God, we thank you for this sister/brother, whom you have made your own by water and the Word in baptism. You have called her/him to yourself, enlightened her/him with the gifts of your Spirit, and nourished her/him in the community of faith. Uphold your servant in the gifts and promises of baptism, and unite the hearts of all whom you have brought to new birth. We ask this in the name of Christ.

Congregation: Amen

Pastor: (to confirmand) I ask you to profess your faith in Christ Jesus, reject sin, and confess the faith of the church.

Do you renounce the devil and all the forces that defy God? **Confirmand**: *I renounce them.*

P: Do you renounce the powers of this world that rebel against God? **Confirmand**: *I renounce them.*

P: Do you renounce the ways of sin that draw you from God? **Confirmand**: *I renounce them*.

P: (to all) Do you believe in God the Father?

All: I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

P: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

All: I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; he descended into hell. On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, he is seated at the right hand of the Father, and he will come to judge the living and the dead.

P: Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?

All: I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

P (to confirmand): You have made public profession of your faith. Do you intend to continue in the covenant God made with you in holy baptism: to live among God's faithful people, to hear the word of God and share in the Lord's supper, to proclaim the good news of God in Christ through word

and deed, to serve all people, following the example of Jesus, and to strive for justice and peace in all the earth?

Confirmand: I do and I ask God to help and guide me.

P: People of God, do you promise to support this sister/brother and pray for her/him in her/his life in Christ?

Congregation: We do, and we ask God to help and guide us.

P: Gracious Lord, through water and the spirit you have made this wom-an/man your own. You forgave her/him all her/his sins and brought her/him to newness of life. Continue to strengthen her/him with the Holy Spirit, and daily increase in her/him your gifts of grace: the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord, the spirit of joy in your presence; through Jesus Christ, your Son, our Lord.

C: Amen

(parents, sponsors and other loved ones
are invited to come forward for the laying on of hands.)

Tyler's Faith Statement is read:

I believe Jesus is my Lord and savior. He died for my sins and rose again to give me everlasting life. God gave us the sacrament of communion to remind us of the gift given to us.
