Year 1, Lesson 23: Elijah

United Israel has split into two. The Northern Kingdom is called Israel, the Southern Kingdom is called Judah. There are many stories that you should know about the kings of each land and the errors of those kings, but we simply cannot make the time and still include the most important stories for you to know. Suffice it to say that we are skipping a lot of material – and that sometime soon you should learn that skipped material on your own. You are preparing to be an adult member of the Church. Take responsibility for yourself and do some reading! Tonight, we consider Elijah, who was a prophet of God to the Northern Kingdom of Israel while Ahab and then (Ahab's son) Ahaziah were kings. Again, we will use the framework of Egermeier's Bible Story book to shape our discussion!
